Welcome back to school Team Rimu!

We cant believe how quickly Term 4 has rolled around! Please read this newsletter thoroughly as it has important dates and information on what we will be learning about this term.

In term 4 our focuses will be:

- Our Culture, students will explore their culture, where they come from and the impact it has on them. Please look at the final page of the newsletter which has some questions for you. These will help your child begin their research. They will also be sent out in homework books in the first week of term. This is completed as part of social sciences.
- Music and sound. Students will investigate the science behind sound and sound waves. Then they will get to explore rhythm with both body percussion and instruments. We will finish this unit with students creating their own music digitally.
- In PE the term will start with some Athletics, practicing in the afternoon in Week 1, then the Athletics competitive day on Friday. From Week 2 to 6 Students will experience Volleyball, TBall, Touch Rugby, Cricket, and Tennis.
- For Term 3 our students practiced their NZDance competition moves and they are looking great! We will be filming their routine early in the term and entering the competition. If we win, some students from West Park will be selected to dance on the competition video for next year!
